The Shell Crustal Imaging Facility (SCIF) is a workstation client-server computing lab located in SEC E124. Its mission is to assist SG&G faculty members, their staff, and students in research and teaching. The facility is not intended to serve as a comprehensive, general purpose, computing resource for the School of Geology and Geophysics. Its primary purpose is education and research in seismic exploration for oil and gas (data processing, interpretation, ray trace modeling, and AVO analysis), near-surface geophysics, and structural geology.

Please be aware of the following guidelines for using SCIF computers:

- 1) Each member of the University community has the responsibility to ensure the integrity and ethical standards in any activity with which he or she is associated.
- 2) Please bring no food or drink to the computer laboratory. You will be held responsible for any equipment that is damaged by food items.
- 3) Do not share your account password with anyone. Doing so will forfeit your right to have an account with SCIF.
- 4) When requesting data loads, please fill out the form located in the folders near the rear of the room as completely as possible. The more information you can provide, the better.
- 5) Manuals should be kept within the confines of SCIF. Our educational software licenses require that the manuals not be circulated.
